Salute to the Grand Master of Pennsylvania - 1734

Greetings Brethren:

For those of you who have been following this series, so far, each of the Brothers we have learned about have had one name, be it a birth name, a stage name, a pen name, or some other type of pseudonym, that they are lesser known by than the name they are most famous by. The problem with July's model Mason is that he has more pseudonyms than most people have fingers, and each of those names is possibly more famous than the last.

The first of these names was invented by this month's Mason when he was fifteen, in order to submit his writings to his older brother's newspaper. One "Mrs. Silence Dogood" was a favorite correspondent of the paper's readers, who was, unbeknownst to readers and his brother the publisher. Taking his knack for news in stride, our Brother continued out into the world of publishing on his own – writing, working as a typesetter all along the East Coast, as well as setting up his own newspapers, including the founding of the first German-language newspaper in America. Combining his talent for writing with his love of the free press, our Brother published his most well-known work under a secondary pseudonym, Richard Saunders. Poor Richard's Almanac was filled with metrological forecasts, seasonal charts, folk wisdoms, puzzles, and practical tips. Most notably, "Richard Saunders" filled his almanac with brilliant wordplay and witticisms, many of which have stuck in America's consciousness until even the present day.

Among this Mason's other accomplishments are in the fields of electricity, demography, oceanography, light-wave theory, thermodynamics and refrigeration, music, and chess. On top of all of that, the Brother was the first Postmaster of the United States, as well as being the first U.S. Ambassador to France. This great Mason, whom we celebrate during this month of Independence, is none other than that great "First American", Benjamin Franklin.

I look forward to seeing you for dinner at 7 PM on Friday on July 1, 2016. The planned meal will be followed by Freedom Lodge No. 118 Stated at 8 PM with coat and tie.
