Most Worshipful Brother Ellison is a fifth generation Freemason. He was raised a Master Mason in Lee Lodge No. 209 on April 17, 1979, where he is a Life Member in Perpetuity and served as its Worshipful Master in 1984. He was appointed District Deputy Grand Master of Masonic District No. 19 in 1995, Grand Senior Steward in 1997, Administrative Assistant to the Grand Master in 2001, Grand Provost from 2003 through 2006, and was elected Grand Junior Deacon in 2006.
