## Masonic Education.

Happy 119<sup>th</sup> Birthday Freedom Lodge!

December is a special month in the history of Freedom Lodge. A dispensation was issued on September 22, 1865, for a Masonic Lodge to meet in Lovettsville with the name of Freedom Lodge. The charter for Freedom Lodge No. 199 was issued on December 13, 1865. The stated communications were to be on the first, third, and fifth Fridays of every month. The Lodge was suspended in 1881 and again in 1888 before becoming extinct in 1890. In 1892 a request was made to the Grand Lodge of Virginia to revive Freedom Lodge. The Grand Master of Masons in Virginia issued a dispensation on January 18, 1892, for the opening of a Lodge at Lovettsville under the designation of Freedom Lodge. On December 8, 1892, a charter was issued for Freedom Lodge No. 118. Stated communications were held at Lovettsville on the Friday night on or before the full moon of every month. In 1956 the stated communication was changed to the first Friday each month.
