This last week, eighteen Ashburn Chapter DeMolays and five advisors attended Virginia DeMolay's 2019 Conclave at Christopher Newport University.

Ashburn Chapter won state championships in basketball and volleyball and were runners up in the softball competition.

Noah Pendleton was elected and installed as Virginia DeMolay's State Master Councilor (SMC). As SMC he will be coordinating the activities of seventeen chapters and over 375 of his DeMolay brothers across Virginia.

At the Conclave banquet, the State Master Councilor recognized Ashburn Chapter as the Most Improved Chapter in Virginia for 2019. Masonic District Two was designated as the 2019 Sponsoring Body of the Year.

As you may have read about in the latest Virginia Masonic Herald, three buses of Virginia DeMolays went to Kansas City in June to celebrate DeMolay's centennial. There, Ryan Pendleton of Ashburn chapter was recognized for earning the Centennial Past Master Councilor's Meritorious Service Award. Ryan was the only Virginia DeMolay to obtain the award, and one of twenty-four internationally.
