Brethren,

In the course of our degrees, and in the King James version of the Bible, Matthew Chapter 7, versus 7 and 8, the text reads:

7 Ask, and it shall be given to you; seek and ye shall find; knock and it shall be opened unto you:

8 For every one that asketh receivith; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

In preparing to sit in the East for a degree for the first time, I reflected on this passage. I noted that until this point I had largely been receiving from Freemasonry,
