Brethren -




We are excited to announce that this year, Freedom Lodge will be an official *non-public* drop site for the Toys for Tots 75th anniversary campaign!

We will then seal the toys in clean plastic bags and drop them off at a Loudoun County Fire Hall following our December Stated meeting, no later than December 8, 2022


