On October 6th, Freedom Lodge and our guests will travel to see the infamous Gettysburg battlefield on horseback.



in a Wreath Laying Ceremony at his tomb.


ATTENDEES ONLY NEED TO PURCHASE A GROUNDS PASS (\$28)
